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Speaker Packard Applauds Court Ruling in Vehicle Inspection Case

CONCORD, N.H. - Speaker of the House Sherman Packard (R-Londonderry) issued the following statement after the U.S. District Court denied Gordon-Darby's attempt to hold the State of New Hampshire in contempt related to litigation over mandatory vehicle inspections:

"This ruling is an important affirmation of the State's position and the constitutional authority of the Executive Council in matters involving state contracts. I want to thank the Executive Council for its leadership and diligence throughout this process, as well as House leadership and members whose hard work helped advance this policy on behalf of Granite Staters.

This decision marks another major step toward ending mandatory vehicle inspections in New Hampshire and is a significant win for Granite Staters!"

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
