He-M 613 establishes the criteria governing admission to and discharge from New Hampshire Hospital.

The Department of Health and Human Services is proposing to readopt He-M 613 without changes as an interim rule pursuant to RSA 541-A:19, I(d) to continue the rule, which would otherwise expire on September 20, 2026 prior to completing the rulemaking process.
