Senate Bans Explicit Child AI Content

CONCORD, NH –Senator Dan Innis (R-Bradford) issued the following statement today on the Senate passing SB 300-FN, criminalizing the creation of child intimate visual representations:

“With the advancement of Artificial Intelligence, the legislature must act to keep children safe. AI has left the door wide open for suggestive artificially created images to target minors. This bill ensures the safety of Granite State children by introducing harsh penalties for anyone using AI to create suggestive material of minors. We cannot allow this explicit content to be used for bullying, or worse, in our state. For the well-being of everyone in New Hampshire, this bill establishes sufficient guardrails to protect children from being the subject of unwanted AI content. This bill is a necessary policy change to help rein in the usage of AI.” Written by Peter O’Neill

Background: SB 300 makes it a class B felony and a tier II registrable offense for a person to knowingly create, produce, manufacture, or direct an intimate visual representation of a child without a parent or guardian’s consent. Senator Innis is the prime sponsor of this bill.
