Senate Passes Universal Education Freedom Accounts

CONCORD, NH – Senator Victoria Sullivan (R-Manchester), released the following statement today on the Senate passing SB 295-FN, relative to eligibility to education freedom accounts:

“Our extremely successful Education Freedom Account program has gone on to serve more than 5,000 New Hampshire families statewide. With the passage of this bill, we are now able to deliver universal school choice for all New Hampshire families. Every Granite State family will be able to utilize this program. Families can now freely choose the best school for their children and let them thrive in a school of their choice. These changes will give families more options that will help New Hampshire’s future leaders flourish in school environments that best suit them.” *Written by Peter O’Neill*

Background: SB 295-FN removes the income threshold for Education Freedom Accounts and caps the program initially at 10,000 students, increasing the program by up to 25% each year. Senator Sullivan is the prime sponsor of this bill. This bill now goes to the Governor for her signature.
