Senator Sullivan Praises Bill Ending Individuals Financially Profiting Off of Crimes

CONCORD, NH – Senator Victoria Sullivan (R-Manchester) released the following statement today on the Senate concurring with the House and passing SB 148-FN, prohibiting individuals convicted of murder from profiting financially off the death of a victim:

“It is abhorrent to think that someone would financially take advantage of a devastating situation. This bill ensures that any convicted murderer cannot and will not financially profit from the death of a victim. Our state was one of only two states in the country that lacked legislation preventing this situation from happening and passing this bill remedies that situation. This new practice will be crucial in upholding an individual’s First Amendment rights in New Hampshire, while simultaneously stopping the potential of individuals profiting off a crime.” Written by Peter O’Neill
