JOINT STATEMENT:

Senate Republicans Slam the Door on \$20 Million Taxpayer Bailout

CONCORD, NH – Senate Majority Leader Regina Birdsell (R-Hampstead) and Senator Kevin Avard (R-Nashua) released the following joint statement after SB 406-FN-A, making an appropriation to the city of Nashua for the purpose of purchasing the former Daniel Webster College property was tabled. This statement reaffirms Republicans commitment to protecting the taxpayers of New Hampshire and safeguarding the wallets of those constituents living in Nashua:

Senator Birdsell stated: “Beyond the uncertainty of whether the former Daniel Webster College property is even up for sale, will the owners accept \$20 million in this aggressive real estate market? I will say it again; Granite State taxpayers will not subsidize a payday for Mayor Donchess.”

Senator Avard continued, “This property was offered for \$11 million in 2017 and rejected by the Board of Aldermen then. I represent hardworking Nashua families who are already struggling to make ends meet, and I will not allow them to be burdened with higher taxes to cover a bad business decision. Their paychecks are not a payday loan.”
