Concord, NH — Senator Victoria Sullivan (R-Manchester) released the following statement after SB 418, an act prohibiting municipalities from requiring licenses for the production and sale of homestead food products, passed on a voice vote today:

“Worrying about your neighbor preparing and passing out homemade pickles and sourdough bread is a grotesque use of government power. New Hampshire’s small communities thrive because we take care of each other voluntarily. Solutions are found through individual efforts not burdensome regulations.”
