Senator Birdsell Statement on the \$20M Taxpayer Bailout

Concord, NH — Senate Majority Leader Regina Birdsell (R-Hampstead) released the following statement after Democrats introduced their bailout bill. SB 406-FN-A, making an appropriation to the city of Nashua for the purpose of purchasing the former Daniel Webster College property:

“Let’s call this bill what it really is – a \$20 million taxpayer bailout. Nashua City Hall let foreign adversaries buy up its land, and now they want NH taxpayers to buy it back.

We’re not bailing out Mayor Donchess by forcing families to pay for his negligence. Nashua’s bad decisions are not *our* bad decisions, and Senate Republicans won’t stick responsible Granite Staters with the bill.”
