Senator Murphy Statement on Senate Democrats' Slate of Tax and Spend Bills

Concord, NH — Senator Keith Murphy (R-Manchester), Chair of the Senate Education Finance Committee, responds to the slate of bills introduced by Senate Democrats (SB 582 FN and SB 584 FN) that would force New Hampshire toward an income tax:

“Senate Democrats consistently ask us to either slash targeted education aid to cities and town across New Hampshire, or increase spending by \$900 million every year, which could only be paid for with a broad-based sales or income tax. Which is it?”
